FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: LOW HANGING FRUIT

As Mayor, my goal is to ensure your tax dollars are spent wisely. Full stop.



As a former CFO, I'll use my 23+ years in finance to bring discipline, transparency and efficiency to Hoboken's budget. Most of these common-sense practices aren't happening today. That's why change is needed — and why I will put accountability first.

- ☑ **Return to a Collaborative and Transparent Budget Process**, working with the City Council to approve the budget on-time, by April each year.
- ☑ Create a Five-Year Financial Forecast, guiding long-term strategic and financial decisions to ensure Hoboken's financial stability.
- ☑ Find Sustainable Sources of Revenue without relying on ever-increasing property taxes or taking unnecessary risks.
- ☑ **Eliminate Wasteful Spending** by bidding out contracts, ending frivolous lawsuits, and stopping the "corruption tax" residents pay when city contracts go to political allies.
- ☑ Reduce Cost of Employee Healthcare through better plan design and administration, ensuring fair coverage while lowering expenses for both employees and taxpayers.
- ☑ **Limit the Use of Debt** for only long-term investments that carry generational benefits and seek offsetting grants or other sources of funding for community benefits.
- ☑ End PILOTS & Tax Breaks for market-rate housing.
- ☑ Demand More from Hudson County especially in public safety and return on Open Space Trust contributions.











- ☑ Require Budgets and Future Impact Analyses for all capital projects and acquisitions before they are approved.
- ✓ Negotiate Better Development Deals that prioritize Hoboken over special interests and stop giving away city properties at fire-sale prices.
- ☑ Grow the Tax Base Strategically by getting already-approved developments built.
- ☑ Restructure City Hall so that resources align with city priorities, we have
 the right people in the right seats across all departments, and they are
 inspired to perform at their best and highest and most efficient level.
- ☑ Maintain Fair Labor Contracts for public safety professionals and municipal workers, with reasonable compensation and mutual respect for both workers and taxpayers.
- Review and Tighten Financial Controls to ensure taxpayer dollars are spent wisely and protected from abuse or fraud.

- ☑ **Bring More Activities In-House** like financial forecasting and planning to cut unnecessary costs while creating better engagement from our current staff.

- ☑ Restructured Hoboken's Water Contract, saving taxpayers \$33 million to be used for infrastructure investment.
- Advocated for Strong Financial Leadership by calling for a transparent, competitive search for Business Administrator instead of appointing inexperienced political hires to the most important role in City Hall.
- ☑ Hired Real Estate Finance Advisors to help us negotiate stronger deals with developers and securing higher community benefits from development agreements.

- ☑ Create Joint Public Forums & Town Halls streamed live and held at convenient times to offer residents a platform to ask questions and engage directly with the Mayor and City Council.
- ☑ **Rebuild Community Engagement**. Unlike the current practice of limiting engagement to online tools and restricted Zoom meetings, I will ensure that community meetings are fully interactive and inclusive.
- ☑ Maintain Reliable Communication Channels, as I have done for a decade, to prioritize transparency over spin, and deliver accurate, timely, and useful information you can rely on.
- ✓ **Avoid Conflicts & Disclose Donations**: As Mayor, I will lead by example by disclosing any political donations that could relate to legislation and ask the City Council to do the same, ensuring transparency and preventing conflicts of interest.
- ☑ Empower Residents with Information by ensuring all city documents, reports, and records are made easily accessible to residents, both through OPRA and by proactively providing information online and at City Hall.
- ☑ Update Hoboken's Website for Better Access so people can easily find the information they need, from city services to upcoming legislation.

☑ Partner with the City Council so they are all fully involved in key decisions and public events, working together for the benefit of Hoboken.

- ☑ Hold a Public Caucus prior to each City Council meeting to review the agenda with Council members and answer any questions.
- ✓ **Support City Council Initiatives** even if they aren't directly aligned with my own priorities, as long as they benefit the community. This encourages teamwork and recognizes the importance of the Council's role in serving the public.
- ✓ Work with All Elected Officials, promote the best ideas regardless of the source, give and share credit when it is due, and help them be the best public servants they can be.
